EXECUTIVE ORDER

No. 26 - 2019

June 19, 2019

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 29-1981 expanded the role of the former Retirement Medical Review Committee beyond services to the police and fire departments and reconstituted the Retirement Medical Review Committee as the Medical Advisory Board (the "Board"); and

WHEREAS, the County Executive issued Executive Order 15-2017, appointing individuals to the Medical Advisory Board with terms expiring June 10, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive issued Executive Order 22-2017, temporarily appointing individuals to the Medical Advisory Board with terms expiring November 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland provides that the County Executive may appoint a temporary advisory board of citizens of the County to assist in the consideration of County policies and programs; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the Board is hereby reconstituted for the purpose of providing expert medical opinions regarding the fitness for duty of County employees to perform assigned duties; making findings of fact to be relied on by the Disability Review Board in determining eligibility for disability retirement for public safety employees; and exercising any other duties and responsibilities necessary to implement these purposes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Board shall consist of seven (7) members, all of whom shall be Board Certified practicing physicians; that four (4) members need to be present to establish a quorum; and that members may participate in meetings by teleconference, which shall count the quorum requirement.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that at the first meeting of the Board after the signing of this Executive Order, the members shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among the members of the Board, whose terms shall be for one year, at which point another election will be held.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that any member of the Board who fails, without an excused absence, to attend three (3) consecutive meetings, or six (6) or more of the meetings of the Board in any given calendar year, shall be considered to have resigned from the Board and that any member of the Board may be removed by the County Executive, pursuant to Section 507 of County Charter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that compensation for services rendered by the members of the Medical Advisory Board shall be set at Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) per hour, based on time of attendance at Board meetings or other services provided at the direction of the Retirement Administrator.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the following physicians are appointed to the Board for two (2) years from the date of this Executive Order:
