SOURCE REDUCTION TIP #1:

Grass Cycle: Use a mulching mower to finely shred your mowed grass and leave it on the lawn.



SOURCE REDUCTION TIP #2:

Leaf Cycle: Rake fallen leaves into your flowerbeds or around shrubs for use as mulch.



BULKY TRASH COLLECTION

Bulky Trash Collection is provided by **appointment only**. To schedule, call 3-1-1 Monday through Friday between 7:30 am and 4 pm or via the online Bulky Application at <http://bulkytrash.princegeorgescountymd.gov>.

Appointments are scheduled for normal County workdays on a first-come, first-served basis.



BULKY TRASH PICKUP REQUIREMENTS

**All pickup requirements will be strictly enforced*

A maximum of 10 items may be scheduled per appointment.

Once you have been given an appointment date, there can be no changes/additions to the pickup.

Ensure that nothing is blocking access to the items requiring pickup. Blocked items will not be collected.

Please prepare your items properly.

Limit of 5 appliances. Doors must be taped shut.

Remove the gas tank, and drain the oil from lawn mowers.

Limit of 4 tires. Vehicle tires only, no truck tires. Limit of 3 each of doors and cabinets.

Smaller household items must be placed in bags or boxes. Limit of bags and boxes to 20, weight limit of 60 pounds per bag or box.

Limit of carpet and padding is 324 sq. ft., must be rolled and tied on ends.

REBATE PROGRAM

Prince George's County is committed to improving the quality of life in our community by promoting green solutions to stormwater runoff. Stormwater runoff occurs when rain (or snowmelt) washes pollutants such as oil, grease, sediment, and nutrients into local streams and rivers.

The Rain Check Rebate Program allows property owners to receive rebates for installing Rain Check approved stormwater management practices to reduce stormwater runoff. Rebate eligible practices include: **Cisterns, Green Roofs, Pavement Removal, Permeable Pavement, Rain Barrels, Rain Gardens and Urban Tree Canopies.**
