- I. **Admissions and Occupancy Plan Revisions-** Update of Public Housing Waitlist preferences and order of selection criteria
- II. **Admissions and Occupancy Plan Revisions-** Allows Executive Director to issue vouchers to PH residents in extreme circumstances when a transfer is not feasible or practical for Emergency Transfers
