



## 7 Energy Efficiency - “Act”

In a management system structure, “Act” generally refers to the continued operation of the planned, implemented, and checked process coupled with periodic review of the overall Energy Strategy approach. The purpose of a periodic review is to allow the opportunity to modify or adjust the strategic approach based upon:

- Performance towards meeting energy objectives
- Feedback received from affected stakeholders
- Changed circumstances and energy efficiency drivers
- Recommendations provided by the Energy Coordinating Council

Specific to Prince George’s County Energy Strategy, these periodic reviews would be completed by the ECC Working Subcommittee. Results of such reviews would be communicated to the ECC where modification to the strategic approach would be reviewed and approved.
