*Turner Continues To Encourage Students to Read*

Turner (D) – District 4, will continue her efforts in stressing the importance of reading to young children through her “**Read 4 Success**” program during her visits to Northview Elementary School and Whitehall Elementary School in Bowie on Thursday, September 30, 2010.

Council Member Turner is excited and looks forward to reading to the third and fourth grade students and encouraging them to read to her. “This is a wonderful opportunity to encourage our children to read and to further cultivate the love of reading. I enjoy reading aloud to them, but I especially enjoy hearing them read because it encourages them to listen, to ask questions and to see that reading is fun.”

During her visit, Council Member Turner will read *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory* by Roald Dahl to the third grade classes and *Frindle* by Andrew Clements to the fourth grade classes.
