1. Vivian W. Shih,, President, Alamo Mexican Restaurant, LLC, **t/a Alamo Mexican Restaurant**, Class B, Beer, Wine and Liquor, 5508 Kenilworth Avenue, Riverdale Park, 20737 is summonsed to show cause for an alleged violation of Sections 6-201(r)(1)(ii)3A-F, 10-401(1)(2) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland and Rules 26(A)(3), 26(B)(5), 26(B)(7), 26(B)(10), 26(B)(13), 26(B)(14), 29 of the Rules and Regulations for Prince George's County, to wit: That on May 12, 2014, at approximately 0245 hours, a call for service was received by the Prince George's County Police Department for a cutting of an individual; that through interviews and investigation it was learned that the victim, Adelo Rajas, Jr., became involved in a fight inside the establishment that eventually spilled out into the parking lot where he was stabbed nine times; that the establishment constitutes a threat to the peace and safety of the community.

Min Zhang, President, Min Guang Zhang, Vice President, Fei Min Zhang, Secretary/Treasurer, Yum's Restaurant, Inc., **t/a Yum's Restaurant**, Class B, Beer, Wine and Liquor License, 12635 Laurel Bowie Road, Laurel, 20708 is summonsed to show cause for an alleged violation of Sections 12-108(a), 12-108(d), 12-109 of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland Rules 1(A), 1(B), 1(C), 2(B), 26(A)(3), 28(B)(3), 29 of the Rules and Regulations for Prince George's County, to wit: That on Friday, May 16, 2014, at approximately 2107 hours, Inspector Ivan Estrada a Liquor Inspector for Prince George's County Board of License Commissioners observed an underage operative purchase a 12 ounce bottle of Corona Extra Beer.
