1. **t/a Golden Bull**, Class B, Beer, Wine and Liquor License – Board request licensees presence to discuss proposed alterations to the licensed premises
2. **t/a Chocolate Martini Bar**, New approved but not effectuated Class B, Beer, Wine and Liquor License failure to renew– Board request applicants presence to discuss the renewal application

Adamu Lemu, President, Shagga LLC, **t/a Shagga Coffee and Restaurant**, Class B, Beer, Wine and Liquor License, 6040 Baltimore Avenue, Hyattsville, Maryland 20781 is summonsed to show cause for an alleged violation of Section 6-201(r)(5)(i) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland and Rules 26(A)(2), 66 and 29 of the Rules and Regulations for Prince George’s County, to wit: That on Sunday, June 22, 2014, at approximately 2:50 p.m., Inspector Robert Lambert and Susan Crossley of the Prince George’s County Board of License Commissioners ordered and was subsequently served a run and coke; that the licensee of the establishment does not possess a Special Sunday Sales Permit for the sale and service of on sale liquor on Sunday.

Toles, Jr. and Timothy McIntosh of the Prince George’s County Board of License Commissioners observed a minor who was working in an undercover capacity purchase and possess a twelve (12) ounce bottle of Heineken Beer; further that the licensee’s agent was not cooperative with the Liquor Inspector; and the alcoholic beverage was furnished by an agent of the licensee.

Fanelli of the Board observed that an event was occurring that was being operated by a promoter; that the licensee was not operating pursuant to the Security Plan that was approved and sanctioned by the Prince George's County Police Department – Office of Secondary Employment; that additionally patrons were dancing without the issuance of a dance permit from DPIE.

Fanelli and Deputy Chief Cristian Mendoza of the Prince George's County Board of License Commissioners observed that unlawfully keeping and possession of containers of alcoholic beverages which have tampered with or refilled.

Rajpara, President/Secretary/Treasurer, Urzula Crandall, Assistant Secretary, Bucks-Up, Inc., **t/a Hanger Club**, Class B+, Beer, Wine and Liquor License, 6410 Old Branch Avenue, Camp Springs, Maryland 20748, is summonsed to show cause for an alleged violation of Sections 9-217(n), 10-401(a)(2) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland and Rules 26(A)(3), 26(B)(13), 26(B)(14), 29 and 75 of the Rules and Regulations for Prince George's County, to wit: That on June 23, 2014 at approximately 0025 hours, a shooting took place in the parking lot of the establishment; that two patrons of the establishment were gunshot victims; that the establishment poses a threat to the peace and safety of the community; that additionally the licensee is not in compliance with their security plan and entertainment was being provided at a day and time not authorized by the Board of License Commissioners.

Rajpara, President/Secretary/Treasurer, Urzula Crandall, Assistant Secretary, Bucks-Up, Inc., **t/a Hanger Club**, Class B+, Beer, Wine and Liquor License, 6410 Old Branch Avenue, Camp Springs, Maryland 20748, is summonsed to show cause for an alleged violation of Sections 6-201(r)(2)2(V), 10-401(a)(IV) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland and Rules 26(A)(3), 26(B)(12), 34, 58 AND 60 of the Rules and Regulations for Prince George's County, to wit: That on June 27, 2014, Lieutenant Jordan of the Prince George's County Police Department informed the Chief Liquor Inspector that JAG had closed the restaurant portion of the licensed establishment; that at approximately 7:00 p.m., on Friday, June 27, 2014, Chief Liquor Inspector Albert J. Fanelli of the Board of License Commissioners observed that the restaurant portion of the licensed establishment was closed; that the off sale portion of the business was open and operating.
