26(A)(3), 28(B)(3), 29 of the Rules and Regulations for Prince George's County, to wit: That on Friday, May 16, 2014, at approximately 2107 hours, Inspector Ivan Estrada a Liquor Inspector for Prince George's County Board of License Commissioners observed an underage operative purchase a 12 ounce bottle of Corona Extra Beer.
