Heeralal, President/Secretary/Treasurer, **t/a Golden Bull Restaurant**, Class B (R) Beer, Wine and Liquor, Coach Lamp Inn, Inc., 9107 Riggs Road, Adelphi, 20783 is summoned to show cause for alleged violations of Sections 6-201(r)(2)(i)(2), 6-201(r)(1)(ii)3A-F of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland and Rules 26(A)(3), 26(B)(12), 58, 59 of the local rules and regulations of the Board of License Commissioners to wit: That on Friday, May 16, 2014, at approximately 4:30 p.m., Chief Inspector Albert J. Fanelli of the Prince George's County Board of License Commissioners observed that the licensee is continuing to sell off sale of alcoholic beverages in a manner not authorized by the Board; that the off sale shelves are not an integral part of the main bar in the main dining room facilities, **additionally** Carl C. Heeralal, President/Secretary/Treasurer, **t/a Golden Bull Restaurant**, Class B (R) Beer, Wine and Liquor, Coach Lamp Inn, Inc., 9107 Riggs Road, Adelphi, 20783 is summoned to show cause for alleged violations of Sections 6-201(r)(2)(i)(2), 6-201(r)(1)(ii)3A-F of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland and Rules 26(A)(3), 26(B)(12), 58, 59 of the local rules and regulations of the Board of License Commissioners to wit: That on Friday, July 18, 2014, at approximately 10:30 p.m., Chief Inspector Albert J. - **Mr. Howard moved that the Class B, Beer, Wine and Liquor license be revoked, seconded by Mr. Caldwell and made unanimous by Mr. Jackson. Mr. Mwalimu votes no. Mr. Jackson stated that findings of fact and conclusions of law be formulated regarding this matter.**

In the matter of Joseph W. Donato, Jr., Authorized Person, Susan M. Dunnavant, Authorized Person, **t/a Country Club at Woodmore**, Concert Woodmore Bevco, LLC, Class C (GCC) Beer, Wine and Liquor license, 12320 Pleasant Prospect Road, Mitchellville 20711, is summoned to show cause for alleged violations of Sections 1-101, 6-201(r)(19)(i), 6-301(r)(5)(i), 9-217(n), 11-517(b) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland and Rules 26(A)(3), 26(B)(7), 29, 75, 78 of the local rules and regulations of the Board of License Commissioners to wit: That on multiple dates (May 30, 2014, July 12, 2014, August 1, 2014), the golf and country club was operating outside of their class of license; that at the July 12, 2014, event alcoholic beverages were being given away; that these events were originated by promoters and were held and opened to the general public; that additionally, the golf and country club is ineligible for a Special Entertainment Permit; that the licensed establishment was operated on the above delineated dates and posed a threat to the peace and tranquility of the community, licensees represented by Leanne Schrecengost, Counsel.
