In the matter of Mark Srour, President/Secretary/Treasurer, **t/a Cornerstone Grill & Loft**, Y.B.H., Inc., Class B, Beer, Wine and Liquor, 7325 Baltimore Avenue, College Park 20740 is summoned to show cause for alleged violations of Sections 6-201(r)(1)(ii)3A-F, 10-401(a)(2), 12-108(a), 12-108(d), 12-109 of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland and Rules 1(A), 5, 26(A)(3), 26(B)(3), 26(B)(5), 26(B)(10), 26(B)(14), 29 of the local rules and regulations of the Board of License Commissioners to wit: That the Assistant Dean of Students at Catholic University of America alleges that from November 8, 2013 through May 2, 2014 there have been seven (7) incidents wherein the licensee provided alcoholic beverages to underage persons, provided alcoholic beverages to intoxicated and disorderly persons, and permitted intoxicated persons to remain on the premises, licensee represented by Matthew Gorman, Counsel.

**Mr. Caldwell moved that the agreement be made a part of the alcoholic beverage license issued to t/a Cornerstone Grill and Loft; that should the licensee be issued a violation of any type against the alcoholic beverage laws for the State of Maryland, the summons dated June 13, 2014, will become in full force and effect for a show cause hearing before the Board, seconded by Mr. Mwalimu and made unanimous by Mr. Howard and Mr. Jackson.**

Matthew Gorman, Counsel stated that there is a pending transfer of location of the Class B+, Beer, Wine and Liquor license from t/a Laurel Sakura to t/a Golden Bull and a pending transfer of location of their Class B, Beer, Wine and Liquor license to t/a Laurel Sakura.
