Prince George's County Government offices will be closed on Monday, February 15, 2016, in observance of Presidents' Day; however regular trash and recycling will operate on a regular schedule

TheBus, a public transit service operated by the Prince George's County Department of Public Works and Transportation, will provide regular service on all routes, **except** Route 51 (service to the Equestrian Center/Courthouse) on Monday, February 15, 2016. The County's Para-Transit and Call-A-Bus service will not operate on Monday, February 15, 2016. Normal operations of the Para-Transit services and Call-A-Bus will resume on Tuesday, February 16, 2016.

The Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement (DPIE) will be closed on Monday, February 15, 2016. Normal business hours will resume on Tuesday, February 16, 2016.

Prince George's CountyClick 3-1-1 will also be closed on Monday, February 15, 2016, and will return to normal operations on Tuesday, February 16, 2016. However, residents can still submit service/issue requests online at www.countyclick311.com.
