LARGO, MD – The Prince George's County Department of the Environment (DoE) announces the following services and facilities will be closed or suspended on Thursday, January 1, 2015. All regular services will resume operation on Friday, January 2, 2015.

Prince George's County Yard Waste Composting Facility	Closed
Trash Collection in County-Contracted Areas	No Collection (Collection will resume on the next regularly scheduled collection day)

TheBus, a Countywide transit service administered by the Department of Public Works and Transportation and the County's Call-A-Bus and Senior Transportation services will not operate on Thursday, January 1. All regular services will resume on Friday, January 2, 2015.

The Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement (DPIE) will be closed on Thursday, January 1, 2015. Normal business hours will resume on Friday, January 2, 2015.

In addition, Prince George's CountyClick 3-1-1 will also be closed on Thursday, January 1, 2015.
