*Prince George's County government offices, with the **exception** of public safety agencies, will be closed on Friday, July 4, 2014 in observance of Independence Day.*

LARGO, MD – The following services and facilities managed by the Department of the Environment (DoE) will be **closed or suspended** on Friday, July 4, 2014

TheBus, under the administration of the Department of Public Works and Transportation (DPW&T), will not be operational on Friday, July 4, 2014 in observance of Independence Day. In addition, the County's Call-A-Bus, including senior transportation services, will **not** be operational on Friday July 4. Normal route services will resume on Monday, July 7, 2014.

The Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement will also be closed on Friday, July 4, 2014, for the Independence Day holiday. Normal business hours will resume on Monday, July 7, 2014.
