Weather permitting, services to resume on Tuesday, March 4, 2014

LARGO, MD – The Prince George's County Department of Environmental Resources (DER) has cancelled all bulky trash, recycling, yard waste and regular trash collection services due to inclement weather and hazardous road conditions. Weather permitting, regular collection services will resume on Tuesday, March 4, 2013.

All operating services located at the Brown Station Road Sanitary Landfill in Upper Marlboro including the Brown Station Road Public Container Pad and Recycling Area, the Household Hazardous Acceptance Site, the Electronics Recycling Acceptance Site, yard waste, scrap tire and appliance disposal sites are closed. In addition, operating services offered at the Missouri Avenue Solid Waste Acceptance and Recycling Center in Brandywine are closed today.
