THE DRAFT IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR THE

The Prince George's County Department of the Environment (DoE) will hold public meetings to provide an overview and receive comments on the County's draft local total maximum daily load (TMDL) restoration plan for trash. These meetings are in accordance with the County's Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System Discharge Permit **Number MD0068284**. Under this permit, DoE will evaluate current trash and litter control efforts and develop strategies to address the Anacostia River Watershed TMDL for trash and litter.
