WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



With the adoption of County Bill CB-87-2012, effective July 1, 2014, business and commercial property owners in Prince George's County are required to provide their employees, tenants and customers with the opportunity to recycle.

PROPERTY RECYCLING

If you don't already have one, establish a recycling program at your business or multi-tenant facility. Setting up a program is easy and we can help! Contact CountyClick at 3-1-1 to schedule an appointment to discuss recycling options. If you already have a recycling program, submit a copy of your Maryland Recycling Act (MRA) Recycling Tonnage Report to the Department of the Environment Recycling Section. Your recycling hauler may also submit the report on your behalf with your business/property name and address listed on the report.
