# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

## **ATTENDANCE**

- Doors will open at 8:45 a.m. No cadet will be received before that time. All cadets must be picked up no later than 3:30 p.m.
- A fee at the rate of \$1 per minute will be assessed for a cadet picked up after 3:30. All fees must be paid before your cadet can return to the corps. Fees will be accepted in the forms of cash or money orders only.
- Each parent, guardian or family representative must sign in the cadet upon arrival and must sign for the cadet at dismissal.
- If your cadet is going to walk to and from the corps, please state clearly on the participation agreement page.
- All cadets must report directly to their assigned deputies upon arrival. Daily attendance will be recorded. If a cadet knows that he or she will be absent, they must notify their assigned deputy. Parents should also notify the corps director if their cadet is going to be absent.
- 2 unexcused absences will result in the dismissal of the cadet from the corps.

## **DRESS CODE**

- Your cadet will be participating in physical exercises every morning. Appropriate athletic attire is permitted for morning exercises. Time will be given for your cadet to change. Your cadet must be in uniform every day with the exception of day 1. Money for the first t-shirt will be collected on day 1.

## **PROPER CORPS UNIFORM:**

- Corps t-shirt; 2 shirts required to be purchased at \$20.00.
- Shorts or pants must be properly fitted with a belt. Shorts or pants with holes, tears or frayed edges are not acceptable. Shorts shorter than one inch above the knee are not acceptable.
- Proper footwear, in uniform, will be solid color shoes, black or white. They must be properly laced and tied. Shoes that are not acceptable are sandals, flip flops and multi-colored athletic shoes.
- Long hair must be pulled back off the face, in a ponytail or a bun.
- Male cadets are not allowed to wear earrings. Female cadets may wear 1 pair of earrings, post style or hoops no larger than 1 inch in diameter.
- Nail polish must be clear or neutral colored.
- Cadets not properly dressed will not be allowed to participate in the day's activities.
