***EXPLANATION OF ZONE DESIGNATIONS**

ZONE	EXPLANATION
A	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
AO	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; average depths of inundation are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
AH	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; base flood elevations are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
A1-A3D	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
A99	Areas of 100-year flood to be protected by flood protection system under construction; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
B	Areas between limits of the 100-year flood and 500-year flood; or certain areas subject to 100-year flooding with average depths less than one (1) foot or where the contributing drainage area is less than one square mile; or areas protected by levees from the base flood. (Medium shading)
C	Areas of minimal flooding. (No shading)
D	Areas of undetermined, but possible, flood hazards.
V	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
V1-V3D	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.

NOTES TO USER

This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program; it does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly from local drainage sources of small size, or all pluvial features outside Special Flood Hazard Areas. The community map repository should be consulted for possible updated flood hazard information prior to use of this map for property purchase or construction purposes.

Coastal base flood elevations apply only landward of 0.6 NGVD, and include the effects of wave action; these elevations may also differ significantly from those developed by the National Weather Service for hurricane evacuation planning. Areas of special flood hazard (100-year flood) include Zones A, A1-A3, AH, AO, A99, V, and V1-V3.

Certain areas not in the special Flood Hazard Areas may be protected by flood control structures.


FLOOD INSURANCE RATE MAP REVISIONS:

- July 1, 1974 - to change zone designations
- August 28, 1976 - to reflect curvilinear flood boundaries, to add special flood hazard areas
- July 19, 1982 - to add base flood elevations, to change base flood elevations, to add special flood hazard areas
- June 18, 1987 - to change base flood elevations, to add special flood hazard areas, to change special flood hazard areas, to change zone designations, to add roads and road names, to reflect updated topographic information
- September 6, 1996 - to change base flood elevations and special flood hazard areas, to add base flood elevations, special flood hazard areas, and roads and road names, and to incorporate previously issued letters of map revision and map amendment
