VOTING UNIT TECHNICIAN (Opening and Closing)

The Prince George's County Board of Elections is currently seeking qualified individuals for the position of Voting Unit Technician for the Presidential Primary, February 12, 2008 and Presidential General Elections of November 4, 2008. This is highly responsible professional work and your services are required for the Primary and General Election Day. As a technician you will prepare voting units, configure peripherals and troubleshoot issues and assist Election Judges.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be registered to vote in Maryland
- Must be able to lift 60 lbs
- Must have own transportation
- Experience working as a member of a team
- Experience with using computers and scripted copy
- Must be proficient in English
- Must have a High School Diploma
- Any equivalent combination of relevant education, training, and experience will also be accepted

ELIGIBILITY TO WORK: Under the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, an employer is required to hire only U.S. citizens and lawfully authorized alien workers. Applicants who are selected for employment will be required to show and verify authorization to work in the United States.
