Voting Unit Programmer/Technician

Technicians/Programmers will prepare and program voting units, devices and disseminate package and supplies and prepare inventory. Mandatory overtime is required, which includes some evenings and weekends. These positions require a lot of standing and working in a warehouse environment. Must have excellent oral and written communication skills. Individuals will be trained on voting units and peripherals.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be registered to vote in Maryland
- Must be able to lift 60 lbs
- Must have own transportation
- Experience working as a member of a team
- Experience with using computers and scripted copy
- Must be proficient in English
- Must have High School Diploma
- Any equivalent combination of relevant education, training, and experience will also be accepted

ELIGIBILITY TO WORK: Under the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, an employer is required to hire only U.S. citizens and lawfully authorized alien workers. Applicants who are selected for employment will be required to show and verify authorization to work in the United States.
