

**PUBLIC NOTICE  
OF THE SECOND REVISED  
DRAFT FY 2010 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

The Prince George's County Draft FY 2010 Annual Action Plan for Housing and Community Development has been revised and is now available for public comment for a period of 30 days. The public comment period will end on July 3, 2009. A copy of the revised Draft Annual Action Plan is available at the main County libraries, at the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) at 9400 Peppercorn Place, Suite 200, Largo, MD 20774, the County's website at [www.co.pg.md.us/Government/AgencyIndex/HCD](http://www.co.pg.md.us/Government/AgencyIndex/HCD) or mailed upon request by contacting DHCD at 301-883-5540.

The Annual Action Plan is an implementation strategy of the County's approved 5-year *Consolidated Plan* and responds to the priority needs of low and moderate-income residents by providing quality affordable housing, building a better living environment, and expanding economic opportunities.

The Annual Action Plan also serves as the application for Federal funding: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), and the HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) programs.

On May 1, 2009, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) released the FY 2010 formula allocations for the County, therefore the Department of Housing and Community Development revised the Draft Annual Action Plan to reflect the following formula allocations: CDBG - \$6,063,206 plus \$198,700 in Program Income; HOME - \$3,120,592 plus \$300,000 in Program Income, and ESG - \$269,322, plus \$269,322 in Matching Funds. This document is the second revision to the draft plan that was made available for public comment on May 21, 2009.
