## Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services

### Substance Abuse Assessment

An assessment is made to determine what, if any, substance abuse and mental health services are needed.

### Individual, Group and Family Counseling

CAP staff include licensed counselors and social workers who have extensive experience working with women with addiction and mental health problems.

### Referrals to Other Health and Community Services

When more help is needed, we assist the client in obtaining needed services.

### Crisis Intervention

Assistance is provided to help solve an immediate crisis situation, along with encouragement and referrals to the necessary type of care.

## Cost

Fees for CAP services are covered by Maryland Medical Assistance. CAP Program staff will help any female client apply for Maryland Medical Assistance if not currently enrolled. Women who are not found eligible for Medical Assistance are seen at no direct cost to the client.
