✓ People **50 years of age and over**.  
Over 90% of colorectal cancer is found in people 50 years of age and older.



✓ People **under 50 years of age** who have **personal or family risk factors** that increase their chance of having colorectal cancer

**Talk to your doctor.**

Private health insurance, Medicare and Medicaid help pay for colorectal cancer screening in Maryland.
