Dear Common Ownership Community:

In an effort to provide assistance to common ownership communities, Prince George's County passed CB-15-2007. Since that time, the Office of Community Relations, Common Ownership Communities has been providing educational services to associations.

CB-15-2007 requires homeowners' associations, residential condominiums and cooperative housing to register with Prince George's County each year. Our office is responsible for registering all common ownership associations and identifying their leadership and managing agents.

Additionally, the information on the registration form will help us identify the location of the community association, either by street address or by the entrance address to the association. Also, we are requesting the name of a contact person for the association. The contact person will receive information specific to common ownership communities, as well as information regarding workshops and other programs sponsored by the County.
