**COUNCIL MEMBER TURNER APPOINTED  
TO CHIEF POLICY-MAKING BODY FOR WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT**  
Turner Tapped by Governor O'Malley to Serve on Workforce Investment Board

Prince George's County Council Member Ingrid Turner (D) – District 4, has been appointed by Maryland Governor Martin O'Malley to the Governor's Workforce Investment Board (GWIB). The appointment was made during a board meeting and reception for new members on December 12.

Council Member Turner says the appointment was a high honor. "I am privileged to sit on the Governor's Workforce Investment Board. I look forward to working with Governor O'Malley and the board members to develop policies that will help keep Maryland's workforce competitive."

The stated mission of the Governor's Workforce Investment Board is to guide a nationally recognized workforce development system aligned with the economic and educational goals of the State of Maryland, and to develop strategies and policies to form a coordinated workforce system from a multiplicity of education, employment and training programs.

Council Member Turner currently serves on the Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation Board of Directors, and the Mental Health Advisory Committee.
