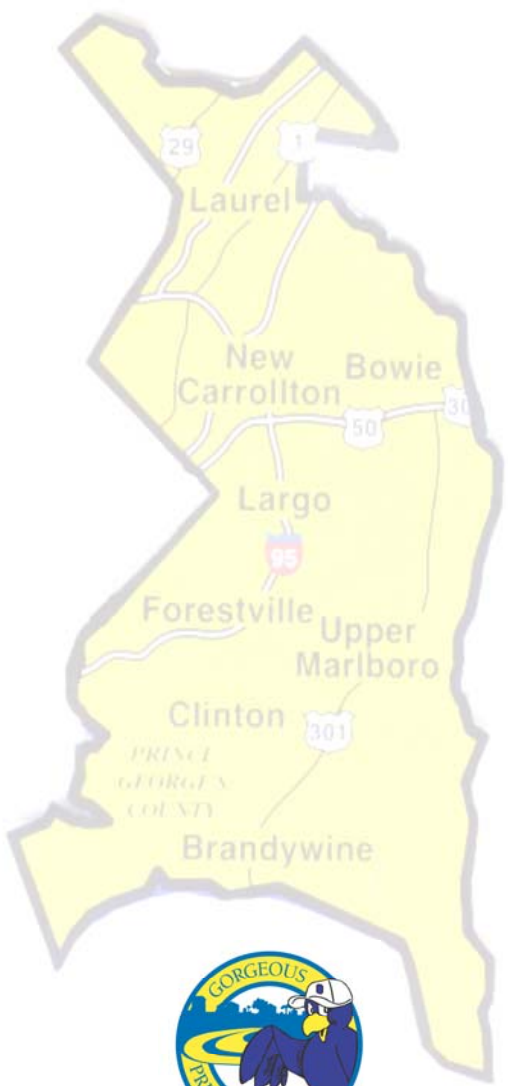

WHAT IS SISTERS TO SISTERS (STS) ?

STS is a rehabilitative program that links female offenders in need of positive influences with women who live, work or fellowship in Prince George's County. This Livable Communities Initiative provides support through one-on-one mentoring, life-skills development classes, transitional housing and community support resources.



“Sisters helping sisters in need of positive influences”

STS aims to reduce the County's Correctional Center population by strengthening moral fortitude through institutional programming and successfully assimilating female offenders back into mainstream society by providing them with essential pre- and post release support services.

HOW DOES STS WORK ?

Mentoring

A one-to-one contact partnership between a caring individual (mentor) and a female offender (mentee) in need of positive guidance and caring support through life's challenges. This partnership is formed during incarceration and may continue upon the mentee's release.

Resource Raising

Community outreach events will enable the STS program to provide on-going resources and support to program participants through educational scholarships, clothing drives and other transitional support.

Social Enrichment

Program participants gain positive experiences through a variety of cultural and educational events and activities free of drugs and criminality.
