

Pre-Construction Meetings Required Prior to Grading and Street Construction Permit Issuance



DPIE requires that permit applicants submit evidence of a completed pre-construction meeting prior to issuance of site development rough grading, fine grading and street construction permits. DPIE is reinstituting this procedure due to numerous permit projects not complying with requirements to schedule a pre-construction meeting as the first step in site construction. Please note the following:

- Pre-construction meetings shall be scheduled after issuance of Green Stamp Final Erosion/Sediment Control Plans and Approved Type II Tree Conservation Plans (or Tree Conservation Exemptions).
- Permittee shall bring the Green Stamp Final Erosion/Sediment Control Plan and Approved Type II Tree Conservation Plan to the pre-construction meeting.
