**Call to Order/Roll Call:**

### **Adoption of Minutes – April 17, 2019**

### **FY 2019 Local Impact Grant Update**

The Fiscal Year 2019 PGCLDC Local Impact Grant Award recommendations from the Grant Review Committee were distributed in advance of the meeting for review. PGCLDC Chairman called for a motion to approve the recommendations for the Fiscal Year 2019 PGCLDC Local Impact Grant Awards. PGCLDC Member Michael Errico stated he is in favor of all the recommended awardees but would like to abstain from #19 because of his working relationship with the organization. The motion was carried with one (1) abstention and eight (8) affirmations.

### **Maryland “210” Highway**

Chairman Chandler stated he was unable to get an update from Maryland State Highway Administration regarding Maryland Route 210. He noted he will continue to reach out to them for information and report back to the LDC at the next meeting.

### **FY2019 Award Ceremony**
