

# RECOMMENDED SUPPLIES FOR BASIC EMERGENCY KIT



**WATER** One gallon per person per day for at least three days for drinking and sanitation.



**FOOD** At least a three-day supply of non-perishable food.



**CASH** ATMs won't work without electricity.



**RADIO** Battery-powered radio and extra batteries.



**LIGHT** Flashlight/lanterns and extra batteries.



**FIRST AID KIT**



**WHISTLE** To signal for help.



**MASK** Filter mask or cotton T-Shirt to help filter the air.



**TOWLETTES** Moist towelettes for sanitation.



**TOOLS** Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities.



**OPENER** Manual can opener for food.



**SHELTER** Plastic sheeting or duct take to shelter-in-place.



**WASTE** Garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation.



**SPECIAL NEEDS** Unique family needs such as prescription medications, infant formula/diapers, pet supplies and important family documents.
