

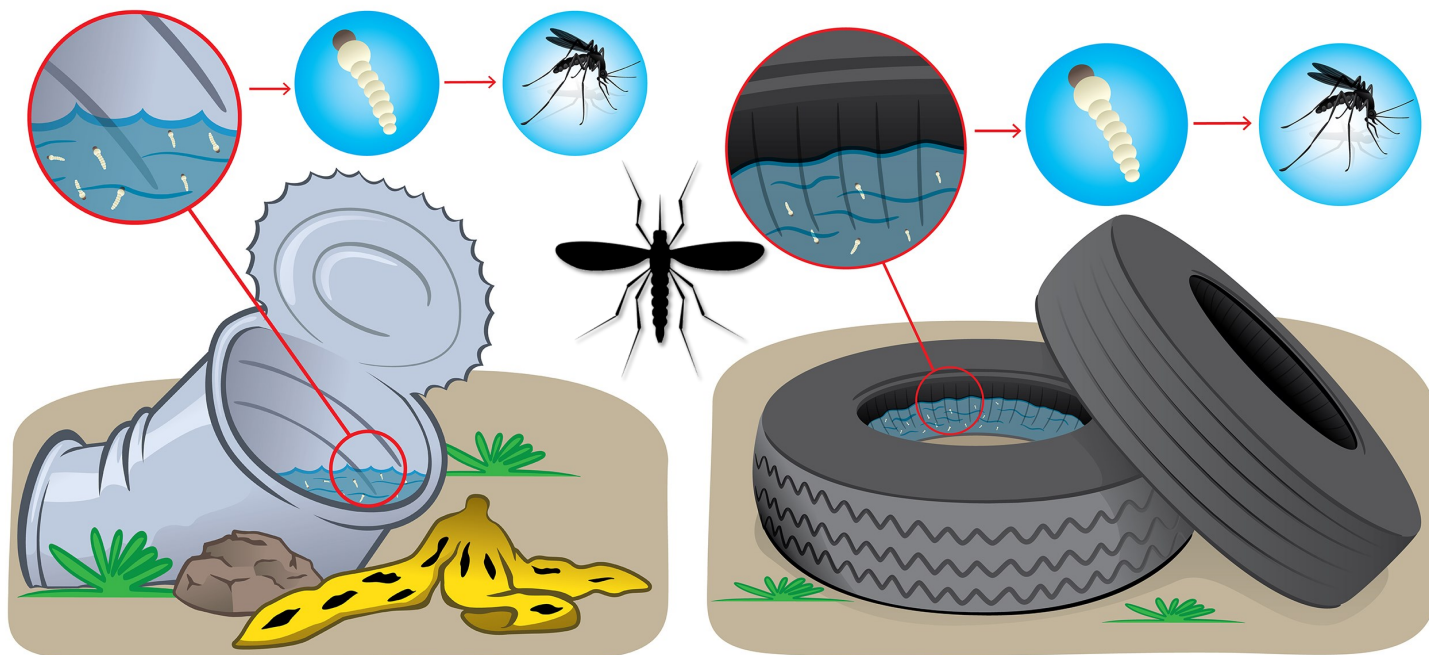

### Tips to reduce mosquito breeding sites:

- **Wear insect or mosquito repellent.**
- **Remove trash and clutter.** This includes discarded tires, buckets, tarps and any other items that could collect water.
  - Bird baths
  - Flower pots
  - Cans
  - Hubcaps
  - Wagons
  - Kiddie pools
  - Empty bottles
  - Jars and their lids
  - Cups
  - Trash cans
  - Pet water dishes
  - Children's toys
  - Tires
  - Boats
- **Minimize and eliminate standing water.** Did you know mosquitoes lay eggs in water? To prevent mosquito breeding, remove water holding containers or turn them upside down. Here are some examples:
- **Regularly clean gutters.** Clogged drains and gutters can create backup that breed mosquitoes.
- **Repair screens on windows and doors.** Make sure children know to keep screen doors closed to keep mosquitoes from entering buildings.
