BILL

AN ACT concerning

Property Tax Refunds

For the purpose of amending the Code to increase the time period a qualified disabled veteran is eligible to receive County property tax refunds.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.

Section 10-144.01,

The Prince George's County Code

(2003 Edition, 2004 Supplement).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 10-144.01 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.

DIVISION 2. DIRECTOR OF FINANCE.

Sec. 10-144.01. Refund of property taxes to disabled veterans.

(a) The Director of Finance shall, upon the certification of the County Tax Assessor that a veteran has qualified for a disability exemption pursuant to the provisions of Section 7-208, Tax-Property Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, refund any County property taxes previously paid by the veteran on the property for any year that the veteran was qualified for the exemption.

1 (b) Applications for such refunds filed with the Director of Finance [prior to] on or after
2 July 1, [1977] 2003, shall be limited to refunds for the current year and the three (3) previous
3 years. Applications for refunds filed prior to July 1, [1977] 2003, [and thereafter,] shall be
4 limited to refunds for the current year.

5 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on July 1, 2005.
