



PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

The Prince George's County Department of Public Works and Transportation (DPW&T) is initiating the design for pedestrian improvements on Stuart Lane, from MD-223 (Woodyard Road) to Regal Court.

The public meeting will provide attendees the opportunity to understand the project design and to ask questions. Maps and displays will provide project information, and Prince George's County DPW&T staff will be available to answer questions. You may arrive at any time during the meeting hours and walk through the display area at your own pace.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

The primary objectives of this project include increasing safety for all roadway users and pedestrians, enhancing ADA accessibility, and providing a continuous sidewalk through the project limits.

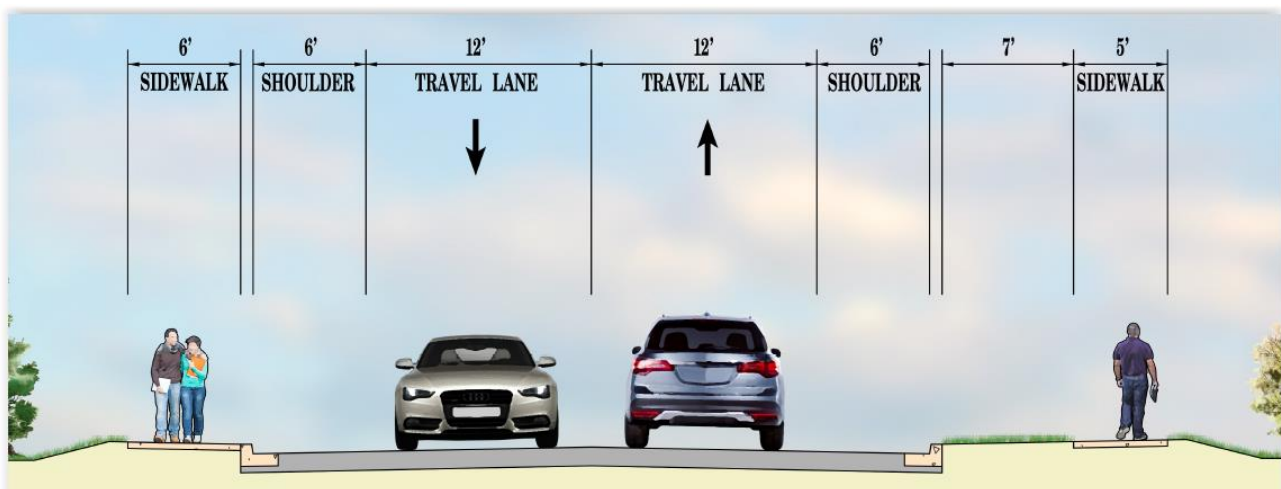
PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

Proposed improvements include:

- Addition of a 6-foot-wide sidewalk and ADA ramps on the northbound side of Stuart Lane from Woody Terrace to Wade Avenue to allow for easy wheelchair travel to the shopping center.
- Addition of a 5-foot-wide sidewalk and ADA ramps on the southbound side of Stuart Lane from Woody Terrace to 450 feet north of Regal Court -- tying into the existing sidewalk on each end.
- Addition of a 5-foot-wide sidewalk and ADA ramps on the southbound side of Stuart Lane from Woody Terrace to 275 feet north of the Woody Terrace intersection -- tying into the existing sidewalk on each end.
- Widening Stuart Lane to 36 feet (two 12 foot through lanes and two 6 foot shoulders) from Woody Terrace to Regal Court.
- Striping for new pedestrian crosswalks at the Stuart Lane at Woody Terrace intersection and at the Stuart Lane at Wade Avenue intersection.

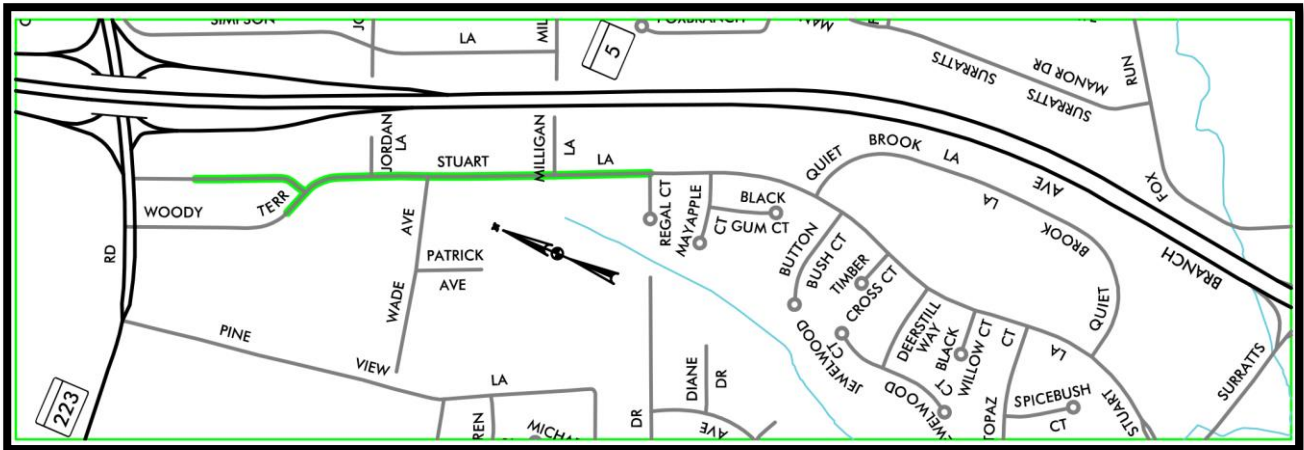
Other proposed improvements include: full depth pavement widening, complete roadway resurfacing, new concrete curb and gutter, ADA ramps, replacement of driveway aprons, and roadway drainage improvements.
