Temporary rental assistance available to help with rent and utility payments for tenants whose employment income has been negatively impacted by COVID-19.

Program starts on Monday, May 11, 2020

Applications will be accepted and last until all available funds are allocated.



Eligibility:

Renter households residing in Prince George's County:

- Must demonstrate that they are at risk of losing their rental housing or having utilities shut off due to COVID-19.
- Must provide supporting documentation of hardship.
- Must have a current income at or below 80% of area median income, as defined by the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development.
