PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY REOPENING

How to Seek Approval for Expanded Outdoor Table Service Seating

The modified Phase I Prince George's County reopening plan allows qualified restaurants to reopen on June 1, 2020, with outdoor seating with a **Restaurant Temporary Outdoor Seating Area (RTOSA) Permit**.

Tables are required to be spaced six feet apart and the seating area must be separated from the sidewalk or street by a three-foot barrier. Wheelchair access and restroom facilities must be provided.

If a restaurant already has approval in place for outdoor table service, they do not need to seek further approvals unless they wish to expand beyond existing parameters.
