NOTICE: DPIE Inspections Division Procedures Update

Effective immediately, the following guidelines are in place.

Unoccupied/Uninhabited New Construction

- Inspections of <u>Unoccupied/Uninhabited New Construction</u> (residential and commercial) and <u>Use & Occupancy</u> (no construction new owner or tenant) will continue as normal.
 - Inspections are:
 - Scheduled via the automated phone system, AIRIS at 301-883-5390; or
 - Scheduled online at https://dpiestatus.princegeorgescountymd.gov/Site/Public/Citizens/ScheduleInspection.aspx
 - As an alternative to County inspections, the applicant may utilize <u>Third Party Inspections</u> with <u>PRIOR APPROVAL</u>. Occupied/Inhabited Existing Structures

- ➤ Inspections of Occupied/Inhabited Existing Structures (residential and commercial) and Use & Occupancy (new owner) may be conducted through the following options.
 - 1) <u>Virtual Inspections</u> (preferred when possible). View Virtual Inspection Procedures at https://md-princegeorgescounty.civicplus.com/3467/Virtual-Inspections
 - 2) <u>In-person Inspections Guidelines</u> <u>NO EXCEPTIONS to the below process</u>.
 - Entire space is uninhabited for the duration of the project until the final acceptance.
 No partial/limited occupancy or use will be allowed until the entire project has been approved and finalized.
 - A separate access must be available to the project area <u>without entering</u> through the
 occupied/inhabited portion of the building. The separate access must be permanent and
 approved by the County inspector.
 - Ventilate the entire space by opening doors and windows prior to inspection. Fresh air ventilation is required to promote air movement.
 - Social distancing must be maintained during the entire inspection per CDC guidelines.
 - Inspection will be conducted with presence of only one person whom has a full knowledge of the project. No other person will be allowed to participate.
 - All parties must wear Personal Protection Equipment (PPE).

Inspections may be cancelled at any time if the inspector deems the space to be unsafe and guidelines are not maintained.

The County may require applicants to utilize Third Party Inspections depending on the size and/or complexity of the project.
