DPW&T Questions and Answers Community Partners Meeting Spring 2021



DPWT	The access road used to access Rt. 5 and the Beltway, Manchester Drive is badly deteriorated. It is a main thoroughfare used to access Rt. 5. Why can we not get this repaired after two years of 311 requests? Three years concerning rain runoff (location or service request number needed) DPW&T receives hundreds of requests concerning rain runoff.
DPWT	What do I have to do or who must I talk to, to get my sidewalk repaired? Sidewalk repairs could take up to 3 years for the repairs weather and funding dependent. We are responsible for over 1,700 miles of sidewalks and we repair over 1 million square feet of sidewalk a year.
DPWT	Why are the trucks that sweep the streets no longer operating in our communities? DPW&T does have a Sweeping contract, it services industrial locations, neighborhood roadways curb lines should be cleaned by the abutting property owner. DPWT	A tree has been blocking the public right-of-way walkway along E. Tantallon Drive for over 3 weeks. Why does it take the County 12 months to address this type of situation? The tree has been removed.
DPWT	Sidewalk repair request was placed September 2018 and to date, no work has been done. What is the process? The process is once the concern is placed into 311, inspected, it is transferred to in-house crew if it is a small project. The Road Maintenance Division handles large projects, using the contractor resources program and the project is placed into the schedule by date of receipt.
DPWT	Is there a documented schedule for county-maintained streets to be repaved? Please see copy of our resurfacing program attached. DPWT	Who is responsible for maintenance of stormwater management ponds? Can the HOA get assistance from the county if we are responsible? DPW&T is responsible for the public (in the right of way) stormwater management ponds. Please place request in 311. We maintain 792 stormwater management ponds.
	What is being planned to provide a means of transportation for residents, who would generally use the four stations along the yellow & green Metro line, <i>which are closing</i> - from mid-May through Sept. 6 th ? Bus Shuttles are being operated by WMATA. The Bus will continue to operate serve on the Route 13, 16, and 17.


