Full Committee

- Consists of all the I-Net participating agencies
 - Prince George's County and its agencies
 - Municipalities (15)
- Typically meets once a year
- Role of the full committee:
 - Adoption of I-Net budget
 - Adoption of amendments to I-Net bylaws
 - Acceptance of new member communities in I-Net Committee

Executive Committee

- Decisions made by majority vote of quorum
 - 8 votes from Prince George's County
 - One each from Cities of College Park, Greenbelt, Bowie
 - Four chosen by Prince George's County Municipal Association (PGCMA)
- Meets at least 6 times in a year
- Provides leadership and guidance to all I-Net committees and task forces

Technical Committee

- Reports to the Executive Committee
- Provides technical advice and recommendations for new projects on I-Net
- Provides guidance to the I-Net technical team on implementation of new projects
- Reviews technical details for new connectivity requests on I-Net
- Oversees following sub committees:
 - Public safety task force
 - Emergency response task force
 - Security task force
- Meets monthly (except months of June and December)

Policy Committee

- Reports to the Executive Committee
- Provides guidance on policy and legal issues
- Defines policies, procedures and best practices for I-Net
- Provides recommendation on amendment to bylaws
- Reviews new connectivity requests on the I-Net
- Works closely with the Technical Committee
- Meets monthly (except months of June and December)

Budget task force

- Reports directly to Executive Committee
- Sub-committee with the primary focus on I-Net budget
- Reviews prior year expenditures
- Creates budget for each fiscal year for presentation to Executive and Full Committee
- Typically meets every quarter
