

CONSULTANT FLOODPLAIN STUDIES



Effective December 13, 2021, Prince George's County will re-initiate performing 100-year floodplain studies (FPS) for county stream reaches. The County's Department of Environment (DoE) stopped performing these studies for two years while a new set of tools and methodologies were developed. DoE has completed that process which allows the use of updated Geographic Information Systems (GIS) techniques and modeling tools to perform these studies. The updated process also enables the County to provide results of the models in digital format. Requesters must submit their initial project data and payments via mail or in-person to the DoE front desk. Once DoE has accepted to perform the study, additional data, when required, may be provided via email too.

The fees for performing floodplain studies remain unchanged and are \$2,500 for studies that do not require a proposed conditions stream channel analysis and \$3,500 for studies that do. An FPS number will be issued by the Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement (DPIE) once the study is approved, and fees are paid. For floodplain delineation approval, please coordinate with DPIE. All required digital files pertaining to the study must be provided to DPIE.
