



How to Obtain a Copy of Your COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card

If you received a COVID-19 vaccination, you likely also received a **COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card** that documents the:

- Date you received your dose(s),
- Type of COVID-19 vaccine you received (i.e., Johnson & Johnson, Moderna, or Pfizer), and
- Healthcare professional or clinic providing the vaccination (e.g., Walgreens, CVS, your doctor's office, or a community clinic).

Obtain a Copy of Your Vaccination Record Card

Vaccination sites keep electronic records of all COVID-19 vaccines that have been administered.

If you lost or do not have a copy of your COVID-19 Vaccination Card, you can obtain a copy of the card by contacting the organization that gave you your vaccine (e.g., Walgreens, CVS, your doctor's office, etc.).

If you received your vaccination at one of the Prince George's County Health Department's vaccination clinics, and you need a copy of your COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card, please follow one of the following options.

Request a Vaccination Card

There are three options to request a vaccination card.

By Mail:

Email COVID19_VaxCard@co.pg.md.us to request a copy of your CDC vaccination card by mail.

In-Person:

Visit the Sports and Learning Complex (8001 Sheriff Rd, Landover, MD 20785) during [vaccination clinic operating hours](#) and request a card.

Online:

For an immediate copy of your record, register at <https://md.myir.net> to download your vaccination

certificate.
