VERIFY BEFORE YOU BUY!

Before you purchase a residential or commercial property in Prince George's County, do your due diligence by researching the following aspects of the property:



File a <u>Maryland Public Information Act (MPIA)</u>
Request to check violations.



Check the <u>permit history</u> on any property and visit <u>PGAtlas</u> for additional information.



Check the <u>permit history</u> and the <u>State</u>
<u>Department of Assessments and Taxation (SDAT)</u>
to verify renovations were permitted.



For single family and short-term rentals, file an MPIA Request for information.



See a <u>comprehensive drainage and flooding</u> <u>report</u>.



Read the <u>Homeowners Guide to Permits</u> for home improvement projects that require permits.



File an MPIA Request to determine if the property has been referred to the Nuisance Abatement Board. Check <u>Data Prince George's</u> for crime stats.



Determine if a property is zoned for commercial or residential use and find other zoning information by visiting <u>PGAtlas</u>.
