RECIPROCAL ELECTRICAL LICENSE APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

SUBMISSION OF ONLY THIS APPLICATION FOR A MASTER ELECTRICIAN OR A MASTER ELECTRICIAN LIMITED WILL RESULT IN THE ISSUANCE OF AN INACTIVE LICENSE.

- If permits are needed, an application for an Electrical Contractor or Electrical Contractors Limited license MUST be submitted along with this form.
- If you are applying for an "Associate" Master's/Limited Master License, a letter from a licensed Prince George's County electrician must be submitted along with this form.

NOTIFICATION OF CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

On September 22, 2000, the Prince George's County Council established requirements, for all Master Electricians and Master Electricians Limited holding an active license, stating they must obtain ten (10) hours of continuing education, prior to the renewal date.

CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

- Ten (10) contact/clock hours
- Current material based on the current National Electrical Code (NEC) — Courses regarding code changes and updates.
- Only continuing education courses obtained from a recognized college or trade school or State of Maryland recognized training program will be accepted and approved by the Board.
- All continuing education courses in or out-of-state must be approved by the Electrical Board.
