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**NOTICE
PREVAILING WAGE SURVEY**

June 20, 2023

Pursuant to Division 14 of the County Code, the Prince George's County (“County”) Wage Determination Board (“The Board”) is responsible for establishing schedules of prevailing hourly wage rates to be paid to workers employed on County public works construction projects. An important item that the Board uses in the determination of a prevailing wage is wage data voluntarily submitted by:

1. Employers performing construction work within Prince George's County
2. Employer associations whose members perform construction work in Prince George's County; and
3. Labor organizations representing employees who perform such work.

The Board needs your assistance as we conduct our annual wage survey, to establish the new Prevailing Wage Rates for employees of contractors performing public building and highway construction work on behalf of the County. The survey is being conducted based upon wages paid ***for construction work performed within the County during the period of April 16, 2022 through April 15, 2023***. Along with the survey, please find the consolidated Classification (including new and expanded classifications [listed in blue](#) for your use and reference). 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PREVAILING BUILDING CONSTRUCTION WAGE RATES

On December 15, 2022, the Prince George's County Wage Determination Board adopted the following schedule of prevailing hourly rates of wages to be paid to workers employed on Prince George's County public worksbuilding construction projects bid effective January 3, 2023.

Workers employed by contractors and subcontractors in the execution of any contract for public works are to be paid not less than the prevailing hourly rates of wages applicable to straight time and overtime work. Reference: Prince George's County Code, Division 14, Sections 2-247 through 2-253.5 inclusive.

Overtime payment is mandatory when working hours exceeds eight (8) hours in any one (1) calendar day and when working hours exceed forty (40) hours in any calendar week. Laborer (Skilled) may operate hand and power tools of all types: air hammers, earth tampers, cement mixers, small mechanical hoists, surveying and measuring equipment, and a variety of other equipment and instruments; may clean and prepare sites, dig trenches, set braces to support the sides of excavations, erect scaffolding, and clean up rubble, debris, and other waste materials. Laborer - a worker who primarily assists a particular craft worker and does not operate hand or power tools. All decisions by the Wage Determination Board are final.

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PREVAILING HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION WAGE RATES

On December 15, 2022, the Prince George's County Wage Determination Board adopted the following schedule of prevailing hourly rates of wages to be paid to workers and apprentices employed on Prince George's County highway construction projects bid effective January 3, 2023.

Workers and apprentices employed by contractors and subcontractors in the execution of any contract for highway construction projects are to be paid not less than the prevailing hourly rates of wages applicable to straight time and overtime work. Reference: Prince George's County Code, Division 14, Sections 2-247
