PREVAILING WAGE SURVEY**

June 21, 2019

The Prince George's County ("County") Wage Determination Board is responsible under Division 14 of the County Code for establishing schedules of prevailing hourly wage rates to be paid to workers employed on County public works construction projects. An important item that the Board uses in the determination of a prevailing wage is wage data voluntarily submitted by:

1. Employers performing construction work within Prince George's County;
2. Employer associations whose members perform construction work in Prince George's County; and
3. Labor organizations representing employees who perform such work.

The County Wage Determination Board is in need of your assistance as we conduct our annual wage survey in order to establish the new Prevailing Wage Rates for employees of contractors performing public building and highway construction work on behalf of the County. The survey is being conducted based upon wages paid for construction work performed within the County during the period from *April 16, 2018 through April 15, 2019*. Along with the survey, please find the current Classification Listing for your convenient reference. **Completed forms must be emailed or postmarked to the Wage Determination Board at the above address no later than *Friday, August 2, 2019*** to be used in the computation of the prevailing wage rates scheduled to become effective sometime in December 2019.
