COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER August 5, 2021

Face Coverings in County Buildings

Effective **Friday**, **August 6**, **2021 at 5:00 p.m.**, all persons, including, but not limited to, employees, contractors, and visitors, are required to wear face coverings while in County-owned or County-operated buildings, regardless of vaccination status and subject to the following exceptions:

- the person has a disability or medical condition and cannot wear a face covering, or cannot safely wear a face covering, because of the disability or medical condition;
- wearing a face covering would create a risk to workplace health, safety, or job duty as determined by relevant workplace safety guidelines or federal regulations;
- the person is:
 - o the only person in an enclosed work space;
 - o eating, drinking, or taking medication, for brief periods; or
 - o communicating with a person who is hearing impaired when the ability to see the mouth is essential for communication.

For the purposes of this directive, "face covering" means a covering that fully covers the nose and mouth and is secured to the head.

Persons who fail to comply with this Order will not be permitted to access and/or remain within any applicable building or facility.
