



PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

The Prince George’s County Department of Public Works and Transportation (DPW&T) is finalizing the design for improvements on Ager Road from MD 410 (East-West Highway) to MD 500 (Queens Chapel Road), to improve safety and operations.

The public meeting will provide attendees the opportunity to understand the project design, the upcoming construction schedule, and to ask questions. Maps and displays will provide project information, and Prince George’s County DPW&T staff will be available to answer questions. You may arrive at any time during the meeting hours and walk through the display area at your own pace.

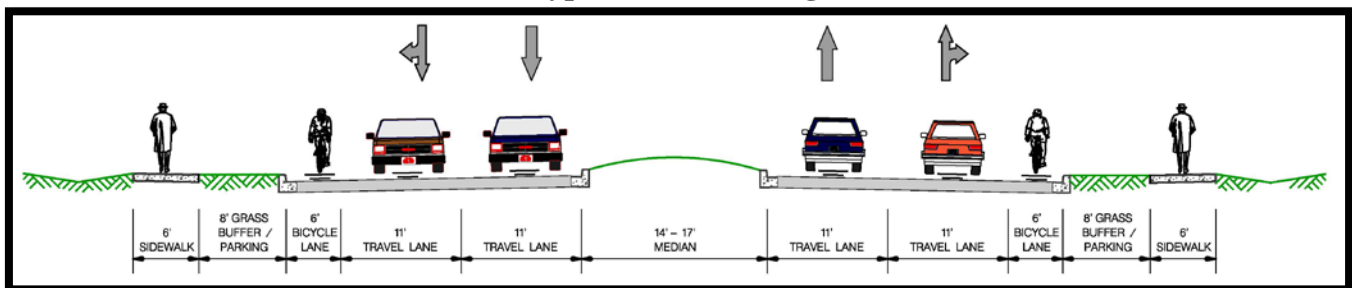
PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

Proposed improvements include:

- Reconstructing Ager Road with two travel lanes in each direction, bicycle lanes, and on-street parallel parking pockets.
- Building continuous, six-foot wide sidewalks on each side of the roadway with buffers from the roadway where feasible.
- Removing several segments of the existing service roads, and extending driveways to the new roadway.
- Expanding bus stops to provide adequate space for waiting and boarding buses.
- “Green Street” improvements, including bio-retention areas and street trees, will help to control runoff to the Northwest Branch of the Anacostia River.
- Repairing the bridge over the Northwest Branch rehabilitating it with a new concrete deck.
- Upgrading all traffic signals, and replacing overhead lighting with energy-efficient LED fixtures.

Other improvements include: complete roadway resurfacing, select full depth pavement patching, replacement of driveway aprons, new high visibility signage, roadway drainage improvements, pavement underdrain, and landscaping. Improvements to Hamilton Street and Jamestown Road are also included in this project, to enhance access to the West Hyattsville Metro Station.

Typical Section of Ager Road

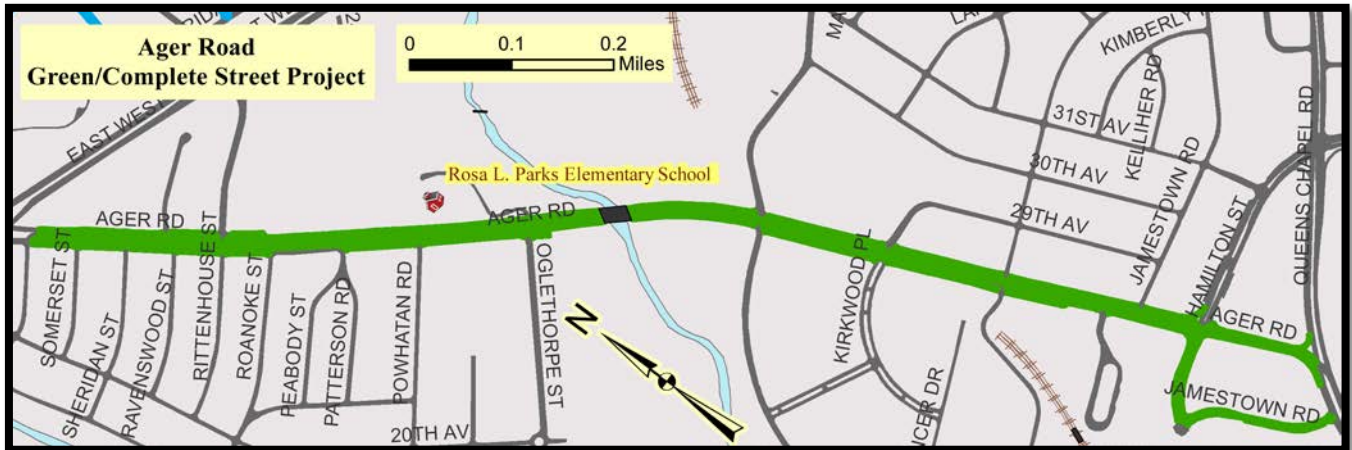


PROJECT OBJECTIVES

The primary objectives of this project include increasing safety for all roadway users, enhancing accessibility, reducing the amount of nutrients in the Anacostia River watershed, maintaining infrastructure in a state of good repair, and promoting economic development.

- Advertise Project – Late 2017
- Start Construction – Mid 2018
- Complete Construction – Late 2020
