COMMISSION ORDER


THE HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION of Prince George's County, Maryland, having reviewed the findings and recommendations of its Employment Panel, adopted said findings and recommendations at a regularly scheduled meeting of the COMMISSION on Sept 26, 2016. Pursuant to the authority conferred on this COMMISSION by Section 2-195, Division 12, Prince George's County Code, 1991, as amended, the COMMISSION finds that **Escobar Inc., T/A Triunfo Restaurant** did not engage in discriminatory actions and wrongful practice against **Nivia Ortiz-Calderon** because of her age, as alleged.

Therefore, in accordance with Section 2-195 of the aforementioned Code, it is this 7th day of October, 2016: **ORDERED THAT**

The Case be dismissed.

Under Section 2-197-C of the aforesaid Code, any party aggrieved by a final decision of the COMMISSION in a contested case is entitled to file an appeal pursuant to Subtitle B of the Maryland Rules of Procedure, Annotated Code of Maryland, within (30) days from the date last entered above.

All cited parties shall be notified by REGULAR MAIL of this action taken by the COMMISSION.
