Daniel Vergamini currently works as an Assistant Director in a federal office of inspector general, working program audits and evaluations on global development programs. Mr. Vergamini oversees and leads multiple teams in planning and conducting performance audits.

Mr. Vergamini previously served as a senior program analyst at the Special Inspector General for Afghanistan Reconstruction (SIGAR) for 7 years. He led international performance audits related to third-party monitoring, Department of Defense advising, and US government anti-money laundering efforts. Mr. Vergamini also worked in other portions of the federal government, as a civilian employee and contractor, working national security issues. He served in the Army Guard and Air Force Reserves for over 21 years, including several active-duty tours.

Mr. Vergamini holds a Bachelor of Science in Political Science from the University of Oregon and a Master of Science in International Studies from the National Intelligence University. He also completed a graduate certificate in anti-corruption studies at the International Anti-Corruption Academy in Laxenburg, Austria, focusing on strategic corruption issues.
