



# FREE PROSTATE SCREENINGS

Prostate cancer is highly curable if detected early. Guidelines from the American Urological Association recommends that men be offered a prostate specific antigen (PSA) test and digital rectal exam (DRE).

Join us to receive free prostate cancer screenings – a PSA blood test and DRE. They will be provided by Dr. Roy Joseph, board-certified urologist. He practices at Mid-Atlantic Urology Associates and is an assistant clinical professor in the Department of Urology at the George Washington School of Medicine and Health Sciences.

## Screening Recommendations

### + African-American Men:

Ages 40 – 70

### + Caucasian Men:

Ages 50 - 70 or starting at age 40 if family history of prostate cancer

- + Blood in urine
- + Lower back pain/discomfort
- + Erectile dysfunction
