

G-775, Emergency Operations Center Management and Operations

This 2 ½ day course is designed to examine the role, design, and functions of the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and their relationships as components of a multi-agency coordination system. The course provides training about staffing and organization, information, systems, communications and equipment needs at the EOC, activating and deactivating the EOC, EOC operations and EOC training and exercising.

Provides the participant with training in the methods and procedures to effectively manage and operate an emergency operations center (EOC) during crisis situations. Participants will have the opportunity to apply what they have learned during group activities. This course will also focus on the coordination between the Incident Command System (ICS) and the decision making procedures taking place in the EOC. This course is especially valuable for senior emergency management officials and any individual designated to serve in an EOC during emergency events.
