

ICS-200: ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents

What is ICS-200?

This course focuses on the management of single resources. And builds upon on what you learned in IS-100 about ICS features. This course describes the ICS organization appropriate to the complexity of the incident or event. It discusses the use of ICS to manage an incident or event and the role and utilization of Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents. This course is designed to enable personnel to operate efficiently during an incident or event within the ICS.

Who should take ICS 200?

ICS-200 provides training and resources for personnel who are likely to assume a supervisory (unit, team, strike team, task force, group supervisor, division supervisor) position within the ICS. The primary target audience is response/event management personnel at the supervisory level.

Prerequisites - IS 700, ICS 100*

*There are 8 different ICS 100 course offerings which includes a general course designed for all disciplines and 8 that target specific classes of work. You are free to complete the 100 level course of your choice.
